# Introduction

## ABANDONED DEVOTION

### 1. Repentance

The Bible clearly encourages us to expect a global visitation of the Lord – His coming. Malachi describes this experience, “But who can endure the day of His coming? Who can stand when He appears? For He will be like a refiner’s fire or a launderer’s soap. He will sit as a refiner and purifier of silver; He will purify the Levites and refine them like gold and silver. Then the Lord will have men who bring offerings in righteousness.” (Malachi 3:1-3)

Here we see the truth so clearly – repentance must come before revival. God must set things in order before He can send down His glory. The trenches and channels must be unplugged and cleansed before the river can flow. To desire the latter without expecting the former is folly. Those that would see the glory of God are those who refuse to hide behind their Pharisaic self-righteous garments. Those who like Isaiah (when he faced the Elijah ministry in his life in Isaiah 6) would face up with the truth in repentance asking God to restore order into their lives.

As we pray over the next 21 days in repentance, God will begin to replace our hearts of stone with hearts of flesh. God might bring us and His people face to face with the unpleasant harsh realities of the ugliness of our hearts. Let us remember that God loves us still and trust Him to do mighty restoration among us as we come before Him in repentance.

### 2. Wholeheartedness

Wholeheartedness is the key to seeing our lives and hearts become more like Jesus. Jesus is jealous over us and wants not just a part of us or an hour of our time, but all of us, all of our time, all of our emotions, all of our joys, all of our sorrows. We must actively pursue a relationship with God Almighty; relationship doesn’t happen without purposeful connection and quality time.

We will examine 21 qualities that bring us toward wholeheartedness such as holiness, obedience, being clothed with the Word of God, stewardship, and many more. These qualities must be applied to every area of our lives. We cannot just live holy while we are at church and then choose worldly habits as soon as we walk out. We cannot steward our finances and not look to our time, family, resources, gifts, and abilities.

As we pray for these 21 qualities to be cultivated in our lives, ask God to show you the places where these need to be developed that are not as obvious to you. Each day meditate on this quality and ask God to birth it in you if you know it doesn’t exist or grow it to a new level if you do possess it. Those that have walked with God for a considerable length of time know to a greater degree the desperation of needing Jesus moment by moment. Develop an attitude of desperation, knowing without Jesus we can do nothing, but through Him all things are possible!

### 3. Revival

Have you felt a little dry lately? Have you sensed God tugging on your heart to draw you back to Himself? Revival is renewing our own fervent love for God, then seeing many others in our community be renewed themselves. Revival is not just personal but corporate, a group of people turning their hearts toward God to give themselves to wholeheartedness and completely surrendering to God's purposes and plans.

During these 21 days, we will be praying for revival to burst forth on campuses and in universities around the globe. First, pray these prayer points over your own life and ask God where greater fervent love can be nurtured in your own heart. Then pray for students on these campuses and in the universities to sense the Holy Spirit drawing them, awakening the dead parts of their hearts, and reviving them with new life. Ask for the whole university to be seized by the power of God and captivated by the heart of God.

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION

### 4. Unity

“Behold, how good and pleasant it is for brothers and sisters to dwell together in unity! ... For there the Lord commanded the blessing – life forevermore.” (Psalm 133:1,3) The God of the universe is so intensely pleased when we are united and of the same mind that He has commanded a blessing. Not just promised, but commanded. Therefore, we can see how it breaks God's heart when we allow the seeds of discord, bitterness, unforgiveness, pride, and a multitude of other sins to keep us from walking in unity.

We want to walk as God has ordained His people to be in community with one another. Following the model of Jesus as Paul writes in Philippians 2, we want to choose to be of the same mind, putting the interests of others before ourselves. Unity is not about everyone becoming the same thing. If God wanted everyone the same then He would have only made one human or many of the exact same one. God loves diversity, and He intends for it to draw us together and not separate us. Choosing the servant posture, pray that hearts will be softened and ears will be opened to hear the Spirit calling for the end of division and a beginning of cooperation.

Over the next 21 days, ask God to build bridges between us and our families, fellow believers; among student groups, campus ministries; between national Christian ministries, international student groups. Pray for a new level of synergy among student groups that they would be catalyzed into a greater move of students going to the unreached long-term. Ask God for the witness of unity to be attractive to those in the body and a pleasing aroma before His throne.

### 5. Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

In Ezekiel 37:11 Ezekiel writes, “Then He said to me, ‘Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. They indeed say, ‘Our bones are dry, our hope is lost, and we ourselves are cut off!’” Even this army faced their own doubts and despair! The doubts and despair can sometimes be overwhelming when

we look to the task before us. The state of the world, the need of the lost around the globe, the lack of workers to reach them, and the personal barriers we face to actually get to the field when we do feel called to go.

Yet, hope is not lost! God is the One who is sovereign over all of these things. And He is the One who is worthy of a great global harvest of souls coming into the Kingdom. God is the One who can help us overcome all of our anxieties and fears, our problems and setbacks, and see a massive movement of laborers sent to the nations.

As we pray over various barriers challenging the emerging generation to engage in global harvest, we look to the One who is not overwhelmed, never worried, never anxious, in order to attain the mind of Christ and His peace. Choose to look at these barriers with the eyes of faith! Choose to see them as God sees them! They are tools to conform us to His image so that we might embrace the pain, but then move beyond them to see the victory that Christ has already attained for us through His shed blood on the cross and His resurrection from the dead.

## **6. Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance**

In Ezekiel's vision, he prophesied to the bones but it wasn't until the Spirit of God blew upon them that the power of life came upon them. We will remain a heap of bones with muscles and ligaments unless we choose to receive the breath of God, His power, His word, His life into ours that we might become an army marching toward a purpose, God's global harvest.

In order to receive the breath of God, we must acknowledge that we are just a heap of bones and muscle without His power and breath within us. We must acknowledge our desperation! We can't reach the lost around the world in our strength – the task is far too great! But all things are possible through God!

Let's take this moment to reflect on areas where we have tried to do it on our own strength, confess our pride to God, and come humbly before Him that we might receive His power to accomplish that which He has called us to do.

## **7. Mobilizing the Army**

Jesus spoke to His disciples saying, “The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore, pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.” (Matthew 9:37-38) These words resound in the ear of every message bearer currently out in the fields. There is so much to be done, but so few workers to bring in the harvest. There are not enough people in North America to cover the globe with enough workers to see the great commission accomplished in our lifetime. But there are enough believers in the world to see a mighty global harvest in the earth today.

During the next 21 days, we will be praying for countries all around the world to be awakened and catalyzed to fulfill their part in the great commission. We need the whole body of Christ working together to see people from every tribe, tongue, language, and people group standing before the throne

of God, worshiping Him in all of His glory. Ask God to move in these places! Simultaneously as you are praying over these places, pray over your church, your friends, your community to be more involved in seeing the unreached hear the message of Jesus' love whether through, going, giving or praying. Every part is needed to see it accomplished!

## 8. Possessing Our Inheritance

“Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession.” (Psalm 2:8) In Ezekiel, the army is raised up to take possession of the land which is the inheritance for the Israelites. For us today, our inheritance is the nations of the earth. David writes of Jesus receiving the ends of the earth for His possession. As co-heirs with Christ, we stand to inherit and possess this promised treasure as well.

The powerful parable Jesus tells in the gospel of Luke about the lost sheep, leaving the 99 to go after one. Imagine the radical love and jealous heart of the Father to go after not one but millions who have not heard. God's heart is that every creature hear the good news. Peter writes, “The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.” (2 Peter 3:9)

Over the next 21 days, we will be praying for cities throughout the earth that are crying out for a Savior, hearts that don't know the powerful grace awaiting them through Jesus Christ. Pray that God would pour out dreams and visions to bring people to Himself. Pray for a mighty outpouring of conviction of sin. Pray for the eyes of their understanding to be enlightened that they may see how very far they are from God and His holiness. Pray for light to pierce the darkness! Ask God to bring in an enormous harvest of souls from the hardest places in the world for His glory's sake!

## Day 1

### ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

#### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

2 Corinthians 7:9-10 – “Now I rejoice, not that you were made sorry, but that your sorrow led to repentance. Or you were made sorry in a godly manner, that you might suffer loss from us in nothing. For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.”

Thank God for the stirring of His Spirit in your heart to bring you back to Himself. (Philippians 2:13) Ask God to work in you the godly sorrow that produces repentance and leads to salvation. Pray for the Lord to give you an instant sensitivity to sin, that your heart would sorrow over sin just as Jesus does.

## Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Holiness: Hebrews 12:14 - “Without holiness no man can see God.” Holiness is a state of being set apart for the Lord without a spot of sin. We cannot hope to see God without working toward eradicating sin from our lives so that we can live holy lives before God.

- Ask God to show you the sin in your life. Pray for the Lord to give you the strength and strategy to overcome it.
- Ask God to mark your life with holiness and a desire to see God face to face as Moses did.

## Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

Seoul National University – location: Seoul, South Korea

Revelation 2:4-5 – “You have left your first love. Remember therefore from where you have fallen, repent and do the first works.”

- Ask God to revive the hearts of the students with fervent love for their Lord and Savior. Revival begins with returning to our first love. Returning implies repentance for those ways that we haven't stayed true to God's commands and His plans and purposes in our lives.
- Revival isn't an instantaneous occurrence. Pray for the students to persevere and not grow weary in seeking God and seeing a mighty outpouring of students going to the nations.
- Pray that these students would be obedient to the call of God on their lives, not being bound by earning money or status, and go to the nations sharing the message of God's love.

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION: WHEN DRY BONES LIVE, THEN WHAT?

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

John 17:20-22 – “I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in me, and I in You that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that you sent Me. And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one.”

Father, just as you, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit are one, we ask for unity in the body of Christ that all believers would be one. Jesus give us eyes to see that You are the reason we are here and You are the only One in whom we believe. Tear down the petty differences and heal past wounds that we might work

together for the glory of Your kingdom being manifest in the earth. Keep our eyes fixed on You and You alone. Jesus I pray for my church, \_\_\_\_\_, and I ask that You would give each person the heart and desire to work with other churches in my community to see more people brought into the kingdom through a spirit of love and kindness. Lord, let Your glory fall upon us as we are united that unity would be a testimony to those looking in to see something different than what the world offers. Make us one Father! In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Immorality/Pornography

- Ask God to break the addiction to pornography off the emerging generation. Pray for this generation to be holy and pure, spotless and blameless as they stand before their Savior and Lord.
- Pray for revelation of the power of God to set them free from all immorality and propel them into the plans and purposes of God for their lives.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

Ezekiel 37:7 – “So I prophesied as I was commanded; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone.”

Thank God for the rattling sound of global initiatives that He is creating. This coming together of parts of the Body that has been apart has given us something that God can breathe upon today. Pray for these global initiatives to come together in unity. Ask God to breathe upon these movements among the emerging generation to see them fulfil their God ordained purpose to mobilize and motivate students toward the fulfilment of the great commission in our lifetime.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Ghana – Titus 2:14: “(Jesus Christ) who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.”

\* Let the burning devotion to Jesus turn into a zealous commitment to go and make disciples of all nations. Ask God to make them zealous for His name and His glory to be made known among the nations.

<sup>a</sup>Pray for the Lord to reveal to each student the gifts and abilities that God desires to use in their lives among the unreached. Pray for God to stir the hearts of many students who would go together to share their story of God's redeeming love.

# Possessing Our Inheritance: Prayer for 21 Unreached Cities

Kabul, Afghanistan

Population: 2,536,000

Major Religion: Islam

National Languages: Dari, Pashto, and several Turkic languages are also spoken by minorities

- Pray many seekers, after knowing many years of war, would experience the peace of Christ. Pray for multitudes of people to have dreams and visions of Jesus and to respond to these dreams and visions with hearts of faith and hope.

- Ask the Lord to bring forth a harvest of believers in 2010 where many hearts believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and are discipled well by Christian nationals and message bearers residing there.

## Day 2

### ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

#### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

Psalm 36:9 – “For with You is the fountain of life; in Your light we see light.”

Repentance begins at the point we see ourselves as God sees us. (Is.6:1-7) Pray for yourself as well as the global student groups that we will see ourselves in the light of God. (Psalm 36:9; 1 John 1:7) As we grow in God, we continue to see more of the perfection of the Lord and the depth of sin within us. Pray for the light of God to expose the sin and bring repentance, that we might be light and salt in a dark world.

#### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Allow the Holy Spirit to Play His Role: Ezekiel 37, Romans 8:14. We see the role of the Spirit and the implications of His role in our lives. Jesus before His departure made mention of the role the Holy Spirit would play in the life of the Christian in His absence as He is to continue/sustain the work He started here on earth.

- Pray for the Lord to show you how to depend upon the Holy Spirit to sustain you in every way. Ask God to teach you not to rely upon your flesh or worldly wisdom but only upon Him.

- Pray to be led by the Spirit in every decision you make. Ask God to make it clear to you the way in which He wants you to walk.

# Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

University of Cape Coast – location: Cape Coast, Ghana

Isaiah 40:28-31 – “Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable. He gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength. Even the youths shall faint and be weary, but those who wait on the LORD shall renew their strength. They shall mount up with wings like eagles. They shall run and not be weary. They shall walk and not grow faint.”

- Though the journey to go to the unreached is difficult, pray that these youth would not faint, be weary or give up. Ask God to give them stubborn determination to depend upon the Lord for all of their needs.

- Pray that they would find their strength as they wait upon the Lord. Ask God to give them faith, courage and boldness as they wait. Pray that God would cultivate in them the perseverance to labor on the field many years because they have known how to wait on the Lord, His timing, His provision, His help, and His harvest.

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION: WHEN DRY BONES LIVE, THEN WHAT?

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

Ephesians 4:1-3 – “I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.”

Holy Spirit, thank You that You bring unity where there is peace. I repent for harboring unforgiveness and bitterness toward other believers in the body of Christ. Lord, forgive me and help me to forgive them. Make me humble, gentle, and patient before You, O Lord, as I endeavor to be light in my community. May Jesus increase within me and I decrease, for the glory of Your awesome name. In Jesus' name, Amen.

### Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Idolatry

- Idolatry is anything that we make more important than God in our lives. Ask God to bring revelation and discernment to those areas where there is idolatry. Pray for message bearers not to let ministry become the goal rather than the goal of knowing God.

- Pray for single-mindedness in this generation. Pray that they would desire only one thing – God and God alone. Pray for them to have an intense desire to please God and may they find knowing God in a deeper way truly satisfying.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

Psalms 107:20 – “He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.”

Ask God to send His word into every part of the global student movement today. Pray for students to hunger and thirst for the word of God, meditate on it day and night, feed on it in their souls, and be captivated by the power of God’s word. Pray for leaders of student movements around the globe to saturate themselves in the word of God.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Romania – Acts 4:13: “Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.”

- Pray for the Romanian Church to stand united behind the young people sent out from their churches. Only together can these young people dare to believe and see God do incredible exploits in their generation.
- Ask God to pour out boldness in Romanian students so they would go and that people who haven’t heard the gospel would marvel at their deep intimacy with Jesus Christ and be compelled to know the One who inspires such boldness in their hearts.

## Possessing Our Inheritance: Prayer for 21 Unreached Cities

Dhaka, Bangladesh

Population: 10,979,000

Major Religions: Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism

National Language: Bengali

- Pray for this rapidly growing metropolitan area to encounter the living God Jesus Christ. Ask the Lord to pour out His Spirit among those seeking truth so that many would find the living water.
- Pray for boldness for those who have found the living water – like the woman at the well – may they run back and tell their friends and family of the Savior and Lord whom they have encountered.

## ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

Psalm 139: 23-24 – “Search me, O God, and know my heart; try me, and know my anxieties, and see if there is any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.”

Pray the prayer of David that ignites repentance in Psalm 139:23-24. Ask God to search you and begin to show you the things for which you need to repent. Take a moment to silently listen.

### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Seeking the Kingdom of God: Matthew 6:33 - The tendency is for us to get carried away by the hardships we face globally today. God says in all these circumstances we should seek eternity first.

- Pray that our hearts, as bearers of the gospel, would not be caught up in grumbling and complaining about circumstances but in focusing our hearts upon Jesus.
- Pray for us not to seek results in the number of people we have led to the Lord but to seek Christ and Him alone.

### Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

University of Lagos – location: Lagos, Nigeria

Matthew 5:44 – “...Love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you.”

- Love must be the first and the last thing said of the students from the University of Lagos. Love for Jesus must compel them to go. Love for Jesus must motivate them to share their story with the unreached. Love for Jesus must sustain them in the midst of being used and persecuted.
- Make these Nigerian students people of prayer. It takes humility and meekness to pray for our enemies. Prayer warriors will see walls come down. Prayer vigils will see lost villages come to Christ. Prayer stokes the fires of revival because as we seek to pray God’s will God delights to manifest His glory among His people.

## Unity Brings Life & an Army

Acts 2:1 – “When the day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.”

Father, bring together multitudes of Christians from various parts of the body of Christ in cities all across the globe to pray for their cities that many would come to Christ. As we together seek Your glory among the nations, Lord would you come? Come and meet with us as we seek Your face. Dwell in our midst as we are gathered in unity. Let a fresh wind blow in the body of Christ – a spirit of unity. Only together, Lord, can we become the army of God that You are calling forth as Ezekiel saw. He didn't see one company or one battalion but an army of multitudes. Bring together the army with one accord. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Fear of the Unknown

- Knowing that God has called you to go, but not knowing what it will be like when you get there. God is sufficient; His grace is enough; like Caleb and Joshua, have faith in God and not your circumstances. Pray for message bearers to understand these truths at a deep heart level.
- Pray for message bearers who continually face the unknown in new cultural situations to know the strength and power of the Lord to hold them and keep them.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

Amos 8:11 – “Behold, the days are coming says the Lord God, “That I will send a famine on the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the Lord.”

Among too many of our generation of young believers there is a famine of the true word of God. There is a lot of hype but little meat. Ask God to create globally a craving for the pure spiritual milk (the Word) among the young. (1 Peter 2:2)

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Nigeria: 1 Corinthians 2:4 – “And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power.”

- Pray for the younger generation to not be concerned with the words they speak but about the Spirit of God in them. Pray for them to dig deep in the Lord and be convinced of God's love for them and for others.

•Ask God to anoint these young people with power to confront those things that are not aligned with God's heart and will. Ask God to guard their hearts that they would not seek the power but seek the One who has the power.

## Possessing Our Inheritance: Prayer for 21 Unreached Cities

Thimphu, Bhutan

Population: 100,000

Major Religion: Buddhism

Language: Dzongkha

•Pray for the eyes of the people in Bhutan to be opened to the truth, just as the scales fell from Saul's eyes, let the scales fall from their eyes that they might know the risen Savior Jesus Christ.

• Pray for the powers and oppression of Buddhism to be broken. Pray that as these powers are broken many churches would arise with people meeting together who have committed their lives to the Father.

## Day 4

### ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

## Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

Ezekiel 11:19 – “Then I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within them, and take the stony heart out of their flesh and give them a heart of flesh.”

The reason why we do not respond aright even in the face of God's revelation of our state is hardness of heart. Begin to ask God to soften your heart and that of your generation. (Ezekiel 36:26) Ask God to remove the stony parts of your heart and bring a tenderness to hear the Lord's voice and a sensitivity to His leading.

## Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Spiritual Eyes: Ezekiel 37:2, Matthew 9:36 – One of the most important inner qualities we ought to have is spiritual eyes to see qualities to see opportunities presented by unbelievers around us to become Christians. If we do not renew our compassion daily toward them, we grow colder toward them. Whenever the opportunity existed Jesus saw it and was moved by compassion to their aid.

- Ask God to give you eyes to see the opportunities He has laid before you to speak truth and love into the lives of others.
- Pray for compassion to well up within your heart that you would move to serve others and pray for them with the compassion of Christ.

## Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

University Polytechnic Bucharest - location: Bucharest, Romania

Revelation 2:10 – “Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.”

- Fear places shackles around us, keeping us from fulfilling God’s call. Ask God to take away their fears and set them free. Revival brings freedom to the places where we have experienced bondage. Pray that these Romanian students would experience physical, spiritual and emotional freedom as they completely surrender their lives to Christ.
- Faithfulness is the one thing we all hope to hear on that final day – “Well done, my good and faithful servant.” Yet, faithfulness is cultivated in an intimate daily walk with Jesus. Faithfulness unto death is a culmination of living truth in our daily lives. Ask God to make these precious students faithful all their days, that when tribulation comes they will stand firm in their faith, fully committed to the Lord.

Matthew 12:25 – “But Jesus knew their thoughts, and said to them: ‘Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation, and every city or house divided against itself will not stand.’”

Lord, come and search our hearts this day. We know that You know us better than we know ourselves. Show us areas where we have let division creep in between us and fellow believers, within our families, in our marriages. Reveal to us ways to mend the gaps and bring healing in those relationships. We choose to take every thought captive and not let the enemy get the upper hand in these relationships. Instead, we come before the throne of grace boldly asking for forgiveness, healing and restoration in our relationships. Let the unity of Spirit mark us. Let Your glory be manifest in our relationships. Lord, we know that we cannot be an army with power if our relationships are broken down and we are not marching together. Humble us before each other and unite us as marriages, families, churches, and the body of Christ to be Your ambassadors. Before the matchless King we bow our hearts and in His precious name we pray, Amen.

# Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

## Security

- Ask God to remind these message bearers that safety is not the goal but making His name and His glory known among the nations and sometimes this means embracing the sufferings of Christ.
- Pray for the courage to embrace the sufferings of Christ so that they might also know the power of the resurrection in those moments.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

1 Samuel 3:1 – “Now the boy Samuel ministered to the Lord before Eli, and the word of the Lord was rare in those days; there was no widespread revelation.”

Ask God to raise up prophetic voices and teachers among students like Samuel and Eli. Pray for men and women who will bring a word in season. Pray for our ears to be unstopped of all the distractions that surround us and pray for the scales to fall from our eyes as they did for Saul on the road to Damascus. Pray for the older generation to embrace the younger generation and mentor them, that they might stand on the shoulders of the older generation and be giants in Jesus to face the task before them.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

South Africa : 1 Corinthians 7:5 – “But as God has distributed to each one, as the Lord has called each one, so let him walk.”

- Pray that in unity masses of South Africans would be mobilized and that differences of doctrine and background would not suffocate the movement. Pray that God would turn differences for good so that each one does their part in seeing multitudes of young people sent to the unreached.
- Pray for students to walk out with faithfulness the calling of God on their lives. Pray for grace as they walk out their salvation with fear and trembling, believing that going to the unreached is God’s mandate for them.

## Possessing Our Inheritance: Prayer for 21 Unreached Cities

Algiers, Algeria

Population: 4,447,000

Major Religion: Islam

Language: Arabic (Official), Tamazight, French (not recognized by widely spoken)

- Ask God to tear the veil that has covered their eyes. Pray for freedom to reign in their hearts, minds, and souls – no longer oppressed by religious ideals but invited in through freedom to relationship with the Father of all creation.
  - Pray for conviction of sin to penetrate their hearts and minds and may the Holy Spirit reveal to them the only way of salvation. Ask God for masses of people to turn to the Lord.

## Day 5

### ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

#### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

Hebrews 10:22 – “Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.”

We have grown numb because our society has bombarded our senses with all kinds of lies. Pray for a breakthrough of God’s truth. Ask God to purge your conscience of every form of deadness and make your conscience and that of your generation alive to God.

#### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Obedience: 1 Samuel 15:22 - “To obey is better than sacrifices and to heed is better than the fat of rams.” The only way we can make God pleased today is to fulfill His purpose by obeying His will-bottom line. We can get so many reasons and excuses why we think otherwise of an impression God is making in our hearts via the Holy Spirit. But we must remember that “obedience is better than sacrifice,” and there is no substitute.

- Pray for the Lord to give you a heart that desires to instantly obey His word and commands.
- Ask God to show you the excuses you have made to not obey. Ask God to forgive you for your disobedience and today choose obedience instead.

#### Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

University of Nairobi – location: Nairobi, Kenya

Matthew 6:26 - “Look at the birds, free and unfettered, not tied down to a job description, careless in the care of God. And you count more to him than birds.” (The Message)

- Generally pray for all students, believers and nonbelievers, Christians and Muslims to embrace Jesus and see the need of revival first in their own lives.
- Particularly pray for Christian students to know that they have God their loving Father who will definitely take care of them. Pray for wisdom to know how to trust God for provision and believe that God has a future for them.
- Those who seek after God and want to emulate Jesus need an example to get inspired and encouraged. So, pray and ask God to raise up strong, faithful, courageous, and wise Christian leaders from among students.
- Pray for confidence for students to know that God's ways are the best, and those who put their trust in God will not be put to shame.

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION: WHEN DRY BONES LIVE, THEN WHAT?

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

Philippians 2:2 – “Fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.”

Father, it is our desire to please You, to bring You joy and delight. We know that being in unity by having the same love and one mind brings You great joy. Come, Holy Spirit, lead us into all truth. Show us how to have the same love and one mind. Guide us collectively to be of one accord. Move on our hearts to remove the stubbornness and desire to have things our way rather than preferring what is better for others. We want to be children who reflect the image of our Father and His Son, not thinking more of ourselves than we ought, but choosing to humble ourselves in order to see the other person's side. Jesus give us grace to walk in Your ways. We ask these things in the name of Jesus, our perfect example, Amen.

### Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Compromise

- Any area where we have given in slightly to the lies of the enemy or our flesh rather than going wholeheartedly after God's plans and purposes is compromise. Ask God to show you areas of compromise in your life. Pray that the Lord would give you courage to admit the compromise and run to God for forgiveness.
- Pray for message bearers to not let areas of compromise keep them from fulfilling God's call on their lives. Ask that God would give them a deeper desire for wholeheartedly pursuing God and not letting anything keep them from that.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

Jeremiah 1:7-8 – “But the Lord said to me: ‘Do not say, ‘I am a youth;’ for you shall go to all to whom I send you, and whatever I command you, you shall speak. Do not be afraid of their faces, for I am with you to deliver you,’ says the Lord.”

Many times student leaders do not grasp the mandate of leadership on them. Ask God to open their eyes to see they are the Samuel and Jeremiah generation – young but called. That this vision of the call will make them set themselves apart. (Malachi 2:7)

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

USA: Revelation 12:11 – “And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.”

- Pray for students to walk abandoned to Christ – not putting material wealth, a great job, the perfect house, a cool car, or anything else before their fervent commitment to Christ alone.
- Ask God to awaken a desire to fully commit themselves to Christ, not withholding their very lives from proclaiming the gospel to those who have not heard. Pray that God would show them the power of the blood of Christ that can overcome all things.

## Possessing Our Inheritance: Prayer for 21 Unreached Cities

Phnom Penh, Cambodia

Population: 1,325,000

Major Religion: Buddhism (State religion)

Languages: Khmer (official), English and French (widely used in the city)

- Pray for God to soften the hearts of people in Phnom Penh to hear the gospel. Ask the Holy Spirit to point those who are seeking truth to message bearers who can explain the message of Christ’s love to them.
- Pray for message bearers to possess extraordinary amounts of boldness and courage to proclaim truth even though it isn’t popular and there is often persecution.

## ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

1 John 1:8-9 – “If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

It is not enough to repent for sin in general. For our heart to fully turn from stone to flesh, we must be specific. In the following days we are going to seek to repent of specific sins. Pray every point for yourself and your generation. Pray that you will be vulnerable to the Spirit’s conviction in the coming days. (Heb 12:4-6)

### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Faith Pleases God: Hebrews 11:6, Hebrews 4:2 - In Hebrews 4:2, we see two different groups of believers. One heard the word and the word was of value to them (healing, salvation, hope etc) but the other fell short of the same word because they lacked faith. In Hebrews 11:6 “without faith it is impossible to please the Lord” –period.

- Pray for your heart to hear God’s word with eyes and ears of faith. Though as message bearers we may be in or going to places where it seems fruitless and impossible, we must believe that God can do it. His word will not go forth void.
- Pray that you will respond immediately with faith and not surrender to the doubts the enemy plants in your mind.

### Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

Cornell University – location: Ithaca, New York, USA

Hebrews 12:1-2 – “Therefore, ... let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus,... who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.”

- Pray for the weights of the world – materialism, position, and power – to lose their grip on these students. If we won’t readily give these up, then revival will never come. Only as we find ourselves sensitive to the Holy Spirit and willing to obey whatever He says can we come into the fullness of revival in our hearts and those of our fellow students.

- Pray for the fullness of joy to be alive in the hearts of the students at Cornell. It was joy that led Jesus through the pain to the glorious resurrection so will it be the joy of these students that leads them from their desire to go to the nations to seeing that dream fulfilled as message bearers. May joy over sinners becoming saints compel us to complete the great commission in our lifetime.

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION: WHEN DRY BONES LIVE, THEN WHAT?

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

1 Peter 4:7-9 – “But the end of all things is at hand; therefore be serious and watchful in your prayers. And above all things have fervent love for one another, for ‘love will cover a multitude of sins.’ Be hospitable to one another without grumbling.”

Holy Spirit come. Let us be serious and watchful over our personal time with You and our relationships. Lord, let us pour out love on one another. Let us lavishly empty ourselves to bless those around us with Your love, kindness, and mercy. Make us people who are hospitable, who welcome without complaining, who choose to generously give to others out of the wealth of all that Christ has given to us. Increase our love for one another, for those in the body of Christ, both in our fellowship and those beyond. Come Holy Spirit and empower us to love. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

### Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Lack of Perseverance

- God has set the race before us and we must run it with perseverance. Whether it is just laziness or multiple setbacks that have caused the lack of perseverance, we must repent. God is worthy of us finishing the race well. Pray that we would not allow any excuses to persist as we follow God but we would run our very best all the way to the end no matter how many obstacles are in our way.
- Pray that message bearers all over the world would choose to finish well and persevere to the end. Though there are many temptations, pray that nothing would deter them from faithful perseverance to the end.

### Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

1 Chronicles 12:32 – “Of the sons of Issachar who had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do, their chiefs were two hundred; and all their brethren were at their command.”

Pray that God will raise up student leaders in the spirit of the men of Issachar who understand the times and God’s mind and will. Ask God for students to be sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit, not choosing our fleshly response but God’s response. Pray for students to understand where God is moving in this hour and seek to be about the Father’s business as Jesus did.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Kenya: 2 Corinthians 11:23 – “Are they ministers of Christ? I speak as a fool – I am more: in labors more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequently, in deaths often.”

- Pray for students to not fear the sufferings that will come, but embrace them that they may share in the fellowship of the sufferings of Christ. Ask God to give them meekness and patience to endure the hardships that come.
- Pray for funds to be released so that many Kenyans may go to the nations and fulfill God’s mandate for them. Pray for churches to be generous in sending out many young people into the harvest fields.

## Possessing Our Inheritance: Prayer for 21 Unreached Cities

Cairo, Egypt

Population: 10,772,000

Major Religion: Islam

Language: Arabic

- Pray for the shackles of Islamic tradition to be broken off of those who are seeking truth. Ask God to set the captives free and for 2010 to be the year of jubilee for Egyptians.
- Ask God to send waves of message bearers to this strategic city in the Middle East to be beacons set up on the hill for all to see. Pray for Muslim background believers to be bold in sharing their faith even if it cost them their lives.

# Day 7

## ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

## Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

Matthew 22:37 – “Jesus said to him, ‘You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart with all your soul, and with all your mind.’”

The dullness in our heart comes because our hunger for God has been replaced by the hunger for other things. Confess to God what has become the priority number one pursuit in your life (it may even been a good thing that has replaced God) and submit it to Him. (Rev. 2:4) Ask God to show you how even good things cannot bring the satisfaction of knowing and loving Him.

## Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Humility: Proverbs 11:2 - "But with humility comes wisdom." We do not only need humility before the Lord but also humility before our unbelieving parents, friends, colleagues and the society at large. Our humility under them allows us to understand their needs and to lead them unto salvation.

- Pray for the Lord to give you a humble heart as you reach out to those who have not heard the gospel. As you humble yourself before them, ask God to give you wisdom in how to lead them to Christ.
- Ask God to give you humility in sharing faith in Christ, that you would not seem proud or knowing all the answers but loving and humble in resemblance of your Savior.

## Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

University of Indonesia – location: of campus Depok, West Java

Joshua 1:8-9 – "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous and then you will have good success. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

- Pray for fire to burn in the hearts of students to spur them on to obedience to God's commandments and laws. Revival comes as we meditate on Christ and all that He has done for us on the cross. May they marvel in God's goodness to them and share their story with others.
- Pray for these students to understand God is with them even in the most difficult circumstances. God's presence upholds us and strengthens us to endure the testings and trials that lie before us. Ask God teach them to trust Him for everything.

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION: WHEN DRY BONES LIVE, THEN WHAT?

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

Ephesians 2:19-22 – "Now therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, in whom the whole building being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit."

Father, You have called us to be in Your household. We often act like young children hoarding our stuff and protecting our own when really it all belongs to You and is for Your glory. Lord, teach us to act like

family members when we are with our brothers and sisters. Remind us to esteem them as better than ourselves and to value all that You have deposited within them. Reveal to us how You look upon them that we might see with Your eyes, hear with Your ears, and with Your heart understand how to love our brothers and sisters more and more. Remind us that bitterness, envy, hatred, unforgiveness, and lies are no dwelling place for God. Rather transform us from glory to glory, that we might be beacons of love, joy, peace, long suffering, kindness, goodness, gentleness, faithfulness, and self-control. For Your glory's sake, Amen.

## Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Materialism

- Certain material things are marked as status symbols in every culture. Pray for us not to be seduced by the “things” that we have as status, but instead store up treasures in heaven.
- Ask God to give message bearers an inner freedom to say no to “stuff” and yes to God without regard to what they have to give up in order to fulfill God's call on their lives.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

Ezra 7:10 – “For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the Law of the LORD, and to do it, and to teach statutes and ordinances in Israel.”

Pray for these leaders whom God is raising up to have a humble, teachable hearts like that of Ezra, seeking first to practice before teaching. Pray for their hearts to be tender toward God's laws and teachings that they would seek to do all that is asked of them. Ask God to bring people and circumstances into their lives to help them learn the important lessons of humility and teachableness.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

South Korea: 1 Timothy 4:12 – “Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity.”

- Ask God to give the emerging generation boldness to proclaim and obey what they have sensed in their heart of God's command to go, no matter what their age. Pray for grace and humility to break from family pressures and pursue God's call.
- Pray for God to give them faithfulness to walk out Christ's life in them in the hardest places of the world that they would be examples in word, conduct, love, spirit, faith, and purity.

Mumbai, India

Population: 12,900,000

Major Religion: Hinduism

Language: Hindi, English

- Pray for light to pierce the darkness in this city. Pray for songs of praise to the Lord God Almighty to resound from the hearts and lips of Indian believers. Ask God for a mighty harvest of souls to be brought into His kingdom for His glory.
- Pray for message bearers throughout this country to be refreshed and revived with strength and power as they wait on the Lord in prayer. Ask God to lead them to people who are open to hearing more truth that their time would be used wisely to see the greatest harvest.

## Day 8

### ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

#### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

James 4:2 – “You lust and do not have. You murder and covet and cannot obtain; you fight and war. Yet you do not have because you do not ask.”

Confess to the Lord the sin of prayerlessness in your life and ask for a new passion for prayer (James 4:1-3; Zech 12:10) Confess to the Lord that you are seeking answers in your own strength. Confess that you are seeking answers from the wrong source. Ask God to turn you and this generation toward Himself that together we might see Him as our ONLY source.

#### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Lives of Worship: John 4:24 - In our daily lives, everything we do must be in reverence of God as He wants it, in the Spirit. Sunday mornings isn't just worship. Our lives are to be worship, honoring God, inspiring and transforming the worshipper, and powerful enough (inwardly and outwardly) to draw unbelievers close to us.

- Pray for a revelation of true worship to flood your heart, soul, and mind that everything we do is an act of worship before the throne of God.

- Pray that your worship would not just be outward acts but true inward devotion before our Righteous King.

## Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

National University of Singapore (NUS), Location: Kent Ridge Road, Singapore

Habakkuk 2:14 – “For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.”

- Pray God will soften the hearts of the NUS students with His love and grace.
- Pray that Christians in NUS will rise up and passionately take their position as ambassadors of Christ.
- Ask God to cover NUS with the knowledge of the glory of God.

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

Ephesians 4:4-6 – “There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.”

Father of all creation, we praise You that You are above all things, through all things, and in all things. Thank You that though we may have differences that we are all part of one body, united by Your Spirit. Jesus come and take away the distractions and petty faults that we have with one another that we might work together for the increase of the kingdom. Remind us, Christ Jesus, that our faith is centered and grounded in You and You alone. We ask that in cities all over the globe the Church would stand up together and boldly proclaim our Lord and that one faith that brings us into relationship with Him and transforms us into His image. Father, work in us, work through us, work through the body of Christ to bring You great glory. In Christ’s name, Amen.

### Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Seeking the Approval of Others

- Ask God to renew our minds and give us the mind of Christ. We have to remember that it is not the approval of others that matters but only the approval of One, God Himself.
- Pray for the determination to focus not on others or self but God. Ask God to give message bearers a true desire to please God.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

Malachi 4:6 – “And he will turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the hearts of the children to their fathers, lest I come and strike the earth with a curse.”

Pray for an alignment between the older generation and the emerging generation. Ask God to give us the heart to listen to the voice of the true fathers so that we can be prepared to enter into our inheritance.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Indonesia: 1 Corinthians 4:1-2 – “Let a man so consider us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God. Moreover it is required in stewards that one be found faithful.”

- Remind these followers of Jesus that they are stewards of the mysteries of God. God has entrusted to them the knowledge of the mystery of His salvation and His Son. This precious mystery is to be proclaimed to the ends of the earth.
- Ask the Lord to impart to these students all of the resources necessary to be found faithful in proclaiming the mysteries and being good stewards.

Damascus, Syria

Population: 1,669,000

Major Religion: Islam

Language: Arabic

- Pray for God to open the heavens over this historic city as He once did for Saul. Pray for many Syrians to have dreams and visions of Jesus and ask that these dreams and visions would awaken a desire for truth and that these people would seek out message bearers who could share the message of Christ’s love and disciple them.
- Ask the Lord to help these people to withstand the attacks of the enemy and give them strength and courage to endure opposition and persecution. Pray for the Lord to raise up mighty, thriving churches throughout the country but especially in Damascus.

## ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

1 Thessalonians 4:3-7 – “For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you should abstain from sexual immorality; that each of you should know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor, not in passion of lust, like the Gentiles who do not know God; that no one should take advantage of and defraud his brother in this matter, because the Lord is the avenger of all such, as we also forewarned you and testified. For God did not call us to uncleanness, but in holiness.”

Repent of any form of sexual immorality in your life (lust, pornography, inordinate affection, homosexuality etc). (Eph. 5:3-5) Ask God to cleanse you from your uncleanness and restore to you the holiness found only in Him. Ask God to give you strength to resist future sexual immorality. Pray for God to give you a hunger for purity and holiness before Him all of your days.

### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Living in Fellowship: Acts 2:42-47 - At the grassroots level here in Ghana, it is common to find Christians exchanging harsh words on the bus to work or traveling. Even in the same Church, believers easily go off by an unintentional behavior of the other. Yes, we are humans, but let us focus on our strengths to grow the Kingdom of God.

- Pray for good fellowship among message bearers on the field. It is one of the critical elements to staying on the field long term.
- Ask God to watch over your tongue that everything you say and do would be glorifying to Him. When someone offends, take it to the Lord in prayer.

### Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

University of Pretoria – Location: Pretoria, South Africa

Philippians 1:20 - “According to my earnest expectation and hope that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death.”

- Pray for students in Pretoria to be bold with their faith not deterred by distractions or people pleasing but radically devoted to see Jesus magnified in all things.

- Pray for an overwhelming expectation and hope of Christ's return to motivate them to share God's love with everyone they meet.

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION: WHEN DRY BONES LIVE, THEN WHAT?

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

1 Peter 3:8-9 – “Finally, all of you be of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, be tenderhearted, be courteous; not returning evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary blessing, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing.”

Jesus, we ask that You would unify our minds toward the purpose of receiving the inheritance of the nations which You have promised. Let us not quibble over minute details but go forth with arms locked together to see every creature hear and respond to the gospel message of the love of Christ. Unify our thoughts to see how best we can serve one another to the end of seeing the gospel proclaimed in lands where they do not know the name of Jesus. Unify our hearts to want Your fame and glory praised in every tongue and tribe and nation. Let us love the unreached into the Kingdom, having the compassion of Christ Himself within us. Lord, we cry out for this in Jesus' name, Amen.

### Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Passivity

- Pray for God to break off passivity and bring an urgency to going to the unreached for those who are called.
- Pray that message bearers would sense God's purpose and plan in going and not for it just to be another option among many.

### Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

2 Timothy 2:2 – “And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.”

Pray for student leaders to grow in maturity in Christ so that they can mentor others and speak into the lives of others on a one-to-one basis. Ask God to pour into student leaders around the globe boldness to proclaim truth and to faithfully teach the commands of God.

### Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Singapore – Colossians 4:17 - “Take heed to the ministry which you have received in the Lord, that you may fulfill it.”

- Pray for these students to radically follow the ministry God has called them to do, even though it means leaving behind great jobs, family, and wealth. Pray for humility and wisdom to make wise choices based on God's heart and not their flesh.
- Pray for the church to send these students out with their blessing. Ask God to bring unity around the idea of sharing the good news with those who have never heard.

## Possessing Our Inheritance: Prayer for 21 Unreached Cities

Jakarta, Indonesia

Population: 9,815,000

Major Religion: Muslim (largest Muslim country in the world)

Language: Indonesian

- Cry out to the Lord for these lost souls! Weep over them! Ask the Lord to go after the one sheep that is lost. Pray for not just one but thousands of souls to be brought into the kingdom.
- Ask God to raise up more laborers who would go to these lost souls and share God's love with them. Pray for hearts to understand their sin and the hope that is found only in the name of Jesus.

## Day 10

### ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

## Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

Hebrews 3:12 – “Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God.”

Unbelief is the root of much apathy today. Confess and repent of the various manifestations of unbelief, apathy and passivity in your life and in your generation. (Amos 6:1) Ask the Lord who is both the Author and Finisher of our faith to increase our faith in Him, looking not to people or circumstances.

## Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Stewardship: 1 Peter 4:10 – We are called to be good stewards of what God has entrusted to us in the gifts He has given as well as the mysteries of God. Since we have been told of the grace of God, we as message bearers must steward the message of God's love, faithfully sharing with those who have not heard.

- Pray for strength to be good stewards as often times it is hard to walk out God's call on our lives.
- Pray for faithfulness in ministering the gifts which we have received that we might be jars of clay who reflect our Maker and Creator.

## Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

University of the Philippines – Location: Quezon City, Metro Manila, Philippines

1 Corinthians 1:18 – “For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.”

- Pray for students to know the power of God through the message of the cross. Pray for them to surrender themselves to sharing the message of the cross with others that many may receive the truth.
- Ask God to raise up an army of devoted servants who want nothing but Jesus and are ready to give their lives to see His name proclaimed in even the hardest places.

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION: WHEN DRY BONES LIVE, THEN WHAT?

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

Deuteronomy 6:4-5 – “Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one! You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.”

Jesus, we love You. We love You with all of our heart, soul, and strength. We want to be a people marked by Your love, empowered by Your love, and guided by Your love. We want to be single minded in boldly proclaiming that love to every person that we meet, genuinely sharing it at every opportunity, and authentically being ambassadors of Christ. May we use every ounce of our strength to see your love proclaimed. Let love set us apart. Let love compel others to listen to our story. Let love sow seeds in the hardest places and the hardest hearts. Let love move us to participate in the global harvest in our generation. For Christ's glory in the earth and in His precious name, Amen.

### Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Unforgiveness

- Unforgiveness wreaks havoc in the lives of those who harbor it in their heart. Pray for revelation of areas where there is unforgiveness. Ask God to pinpoint the precise situation, reason and purpose for the unforgiveness.
- Pray for reconciliation among those who harbor unforgiveness. Ask God that they would not let the resulting bitterness from unforgiveness keep them from clearly discerning God's will and call.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

2 Timothy 2:15 – “Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.”

Pray for the emerging generation to be diligent in seeking God’s face and coming before Him with humility. Pray for God’s anointing on all those who are involved in teaching, preaching or any form of declaring God’s word. Use these verses to pray for them. (2 Timothy 4:2)

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Philippines – Philippians 1:20 – “According to my earnest expectation and hope that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death.”

- Ask God to give these students boldness to share the good news and not be ashamed. Pray for multitudes of these students to be filled with boldness that compels them to share.
- Pray for these students to be completely devoted to Christ that whether God calls them to magnify Himself through life or death that they would do it all for the glory of God.

## Possessing Our Inheritance: Prayer for 21 Unreached Cities

Tehran, Iran

Population: 7,380,000

Major Religion: Islam

Language: Persian (official), Azeri, Kurdish, Mazandarani, Gilaki

- Among the recent unrest with the presidential elections, pray for light to pierce hearts who are seeking something other more fundamental Islamic thinking. Pray for Iranians to understand the truth of the gospel.
- Ask the Lord to use this time of political tension to bring many into the kingdom. Pray for the veil of illusions about Islam to be torn down and truth to reign.

## ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

Psalms 119:136 – “Rivers of water run down from my eyes, because men do not keep Your law.”

Before we can effectively reach the nations we must have a burden for those around us. Repent of a lack of compassion for the lost around you. Ask for a heart for the lost. (Psalms 119:136; Romans 9:1-3) Ask the Lord of hosts to fill you with the same compassion that Jesus had as He looked upon the multitudes.

### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Knowing the Powerful Presence of God: Exodus 33:15 – Moses was a man who knew the powerful presence of God and knew that it was pointless to go anywhere without it.

- Pray for a greater understanding of God’s presence in your life. Ask Him for an encounter with His presence that would shape your understanding.
- Ask God to teach you how to depend upon His presence and not your flesh, especially in times of trial. Pray for humility to remember that God’s ways are higher than your ways.

### Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

Hanyang University – Locations: Seoul & Ansan, South Korea

Hebrews 12:28-29 – “Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. For our God is a consuming fire.”

- Ask for students to burn with fire in their hearts of wholeheartedness toward God. Before we can minister to others the revival must begin in our own hearts. We must give him all that we have and all that we are in complete surrender. We must let the fire of His presence purge us of all of our sins and catalyze us into our destinies.
- We must respond to God with the fear of the Lord, knowing only He can revive us. Godly fear recognizes that God is sinless and we are sinful and the only bridge across that gap is His blood. We must live understanding that we are nothing without Christ in us, Christ through us, Christ before us, Christ behind us, Christ below us, Christ above us. Jesus Christ is our only hope and His fire burning within us is a constant reminder of our need for Him. Pray for the fear of the Lord to penetrate the

hearts of students in a deep and personal way.

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION: WHEN DRY BONES LIVE, THEN WHAT?

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

Psalm 27:4 – “One thing I have desired of the LORD, and that will I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD and to inquire in His temple.”

Father God, as the body of Christ and the army of the Lord, make us single-minded in our focus on You and You alone. Our cry is to be like Mary who sat at Your feet and You said that she had chosen the better part and it would not be taken away from her. Lord, we choose to sit and wait, to look and behold, to listen and inquire in Your presence. We look not to benefits or answered prayer, but to You and Your character. We declare that You are glorious and awesome to behold. Your justice and mercy, Your wisdom and grace, Your splendor and majesty are almost too much to fathom. We do not want to pursue programs, doctrines, ideologies, or dogmas. We do not rest in achievements, laurels, merits, or labors. Our end goal is You. Our destiny to be like You, conformed into Your image. Let nothing distract us from fixing our eyes on the Author and Finisher of our faith. When troubles arise, let us be single-minded in looking to You and not our circumstances. We march forth in Your righteousness, clothed in Your mercy, upheld by Your grace, and compelled to bear Your good news. Lord, lead us on toward You and Your purposes on earth. In Jesus' glorious and majestic name, Amen.

### Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

#### Negative Parental Influence

- Whether this is from their parents' not being believers or from believing parents who insist on ungodly goals, we must honor our parents but not more than our love for God. God must be number one in our honor and love.
- Pray for message bearers not to let their parents keep them from going after God and His call on their lives even if it means not honoring their parents' desires for them to have good jobs earning lots of money.

### Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

Psalm 68:11 – “The Lord gave the word; great was the company of those who proclaimed it.”

Ask God to raise up anointed voices through the media. Pray for powerful prophetic journalists to be raised up and those already existing anointed all around the world. Ask God to give their mouths boldness to proclaim truth and light in the darkness.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

India – Ephesians 2:10 – “For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.”

- Pray for multitudes of students throughout Indian campuses to understand the good works that God has prepared beforehand as going to the nations to share God’s love.
- Pray for these students who are mobilized to be convinced that they are God’s workmanship, uniquely created, prophetically destined to be God’s ambassador.

## Possessing Our Inheritance: Prayer for 21 Unreached Cities

Amman, Jordan

Population: 2,525,000

Major Religion: Islam

Language: Arabic

- Often friendly to foreigners and especially western governments, Jordan is a strategic country that borders more difficult countries like Syria and Saudi Arabia. Pray for favor for message bearers to develop relationships with Jordanians who are hungry for the gospel, ask God to broaden their networks to find those who are seeking.
- As Jordan is considered to be the cradle of civilization, pray that an awakening would arise in Amman and souls would come to know their Creator. Ask God for this awakening to spread to cities throughout the country and the region.

# Day 12

## ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

Luke 12:15 – “And He (Jesus) said to them, “Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one’s life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses.”

Materialism is the prevalent type of idolatry in our age. Confess any form of covetousness and the measuring of your worth by the abundance of things you have. (Job 31:24-28) Ask God to replace the materialism with a heart of generosity like the widow who gave all that she had into the offering.

## Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Being Clothed with the Word of God: Colossians 3:16 – Paul admonishes us to let the word of Christ dwell in us richly. We must be careful what we allow our hearts and minds to dwell and meditate upon. We must not only know what the Word of God says but let it breathe life into us that we may in turn breathe life into others.

- Pray for God to guard your eyes and ears that you would not dwell on any unholy thing, but keep yourself pure and focused on God alone.
- Ask God to sink the Word of God deep into your heart and soul that you would be clothed with it when you arise in the morning and when you go to sleep, the first word out of your mouth is you speaking Scripture back to God.

## Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

University of Ghana - location: Legon, Ghana

Isaiah 42:1-2,4 – “Behold, My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One in whom My soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will not fail nor be discouraged, till He has established justice in the earth; and the coastlands shall wait for His law.”

- Praise God that He upholds His children. Pray for students surrendered to the Lord to know that He delights in them.
- Through revival, pray for the students to know that the great commission can only be accomplished by God’s Spirit resting upon us and flowing through us.
- Pray for these students to know that the Lord God Almighty will not fail in seeing His plans realized nor will He be discouraged by setbacks, finances, or the enemy. God will prevail!

## Unity Brings Life & an Army

Philippians 1:21 – “For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain.”

Lord Jesus, see in me my tendencies to wander and drift. Search out my anxieties and unbelief. I want to wholeheartedly say that living for me is Christ and not my flesh. Unite my desires to match Yours. I want my purposes and plans to be Yours for my life. I want to be in unity with You. I want to know without a doubt that I am completely Yours and have no fear of death because death on earth means life with

You face to face. Make me see the reality of living everyday face to face with You, not as an afterthought. Lord, I confess to You my fears of going to hostile places in the world where Christians are persecuted. Teach me, Jesus, not to fear but rest in Your truth – living is all about doing Christ’s will and dying is all about being face to face with our Savior. Help us Father to choose to give up our lives that others might know this truth of Christ as our only focus, vision, light, and hope. Let our generation unite around this single-minded focus of serving only One, loving only One, and bearing the image of One, our Redeemer Jesus Christ in whose name we pray, Amen.

## Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

### Guilt

- Whether it is about minor indiscretions or major ongoing addictions, we cannot allow the enemy’s schemes to focus on the sin to keep us in guilt. Pray for eyes to be opened and hearts to understand God’s everlasting love and unending desire for relationship.
- Ask God to remind message bearers that once we have confessed our sin and asked God for forgiveness that He has forgiven us and we must also forgive ourselves. God does not want us living in guilt, but rather walking in freedom. Pray for the guilt not to keep these message bearers from running the race.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

Titus 1:11 – “Whose mouths must be stopped who subvert whole households, teaching things which they ought not, for the sake of dishonest gain.”

In order to receive the breath of God, we must distinguish between God talking and the multitude of other voices around us. Ask God to silence the wrong doctrines, dishonest voices, and our fleshly attitudes that are paralysing the army of God. Ask God to open our ears to hear only His voice.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

China: Colossians 3:14-15 – “But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection. And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful.”

- Pray that these faithful saints would be marked by the love of Christ as they go to the nations. Pray that they would be overcome by such love for Christ that they would be ready to go to those who have not heard of Christ’s love.
- Ask God to guard these students with peace, though suffering and trials come. Pray that through everything they would have thankful hearts.

Pyongyang, North Korea

Population: 3,255,000

Major Religion: Buddhist and Confucianism

Language: Korean

- Pray for the few believers in this city to be bold despite persecution; currently worldwide, North Korea is the country with the most severe persecution of Christians. Pray for seekers to believe in the Lord Jesus Christ while still counting the cost.
  - Pray for favor to be granted and doors opened so message bearers can get into the country and for those already there to be able to stay. Ask God to create deep hunger in North Koreans for hope and real relationship.

## Day 13

### ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

#### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

Luke 16:10-12 – “He who is faithful in what is least is faithful also in much; and he who is unjust in what is least is unjust also in much. Therefore if you have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches? And if you have not been faithful in what is another man’s, who will give you what is your own?”

Ours is a generation of wasters. God calls us to be good stewards of the resources with which He has entrusted us. Look at your life and confess and repent of every form of waste of money, time, and giving either by not employing them to their full potential or by using them for things that do not bring God glory. (1 Corinthians 15:10)

#### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Embracing a Lifestyle of Devoted Prayer: Matthew 6:6 – Prayer is not just an activity but a lifestyle of ongoing conversation with God. We must seek God in the secret place and we must pray without ceasing. We cannot choose one without the other or we do not know communion with God. (1 Thessalonians 5:17)

- Pray for God to give you a hunger for prayer and time just with Him. Ask God to show you the joys of spending time in His presence and cultivating a deeper relationship with Him.

- Ask God to teach you how to have a lifestyle of devoted prayer. Some people have a prayer life but not a lifestyle of prayer. Ask God to cultivate a lifestyle of prayer in your life.

## Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

University of Jos – location: Jos, Nigeria

1 Peter 2:9 – “But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of the darkness into His marvelous light.”

- Ask the Lord of the harvest to remind these youth that they are a CHOSEN generation. God has a unique calling on the young people of today.
- Pour out a spirit of revival that would bring a focus on holiness and holy living among these blessed youth. Ask God to consecrate many for the work of going to the unreached and that they would be called forth in this hour.
- Ask God to show many students that they are a CHOSEN for a purpose – to proclaim the praises of the Lord Almighty. Ask the Lord to give them boldness as they seek to proclaim the praises of God in dark, hard places.

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION: WHEN DRY BONES LIVE, THEN WHAT?

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

Philippians 3:8-10 – “Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ and be found in Him, ..., that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death.”

Father, I cry out for this generation to be united in their understanding of Christ and that You are worthy of mine and their suffering. Oh Lord, that I may gain Christ. What more excellent ambition, more lofty goal, more exquisite dream than to be found in You! Jesus, the cost of going to hard places to sow seeds in unplowed lands is great. The pain of saying goodbye to family, the great longing to be with family and friends on special occasions and holidays, the strain of living in another culture, and the stress of learning another language is all rubbish for You are worth all of this and much more. You are worthy of my sufferings so that I can truly find myself in You and You alone. I cry out with the angels and the hosts of heaven, “Worthy is the Lamb! Worthy is the Lamb!” Let my heart cry be “You are worthy” when the cost seems too great to bear. Let my soul shout, “Blessed be the name of the Lord” when I cannot see through the river of tears. Let my tongue proclaim, “Great is the Lord and greatly to be praised” when the harvest has not come and the sowing of seeds is difficult on rocky ground. Let the emerging generation proclaim this with one voice. In Jesus’ name alone, Amen.

# Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

## Worldliness

- Ask God to help us to resist the temptation to look and act like the world. Sometimes we get caught up in the ways of the world and fail to distinguish between the world and God's Kingdom. Pray for eyes, ears, and hearts that would discern God's Kingdom.
- Pray for the Spirit to rest upon message bearers and set them apart for service in His Kingdom. Pray for God to give them grace to walk in His ways and statutes.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

1 John 1:6-7 – “If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.”

Today there is too much reluctance to confront our peers with the truth. Yet it is ‘iron that sharpens iron.’ (Prov. 27:17) Pray that God will make us more willing to walk in the light with one another. Pray for boldness among the emerging generation to speak truth, walk in the light, and expose the darkness.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Malaysia: Galatians 2:20 – “I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God who loved me and gave Himself for me.”

- Ask God to saturate campuses in Malaysia with the spirit of the crucified life that each student would not live for themselves but for Christ and Him alone, dying to themselves and their desires that they would choose God's ways and God's heart in every circumstance.
- Pray for faith to arise in these students that though hard times come they would rely on the One who loves them and gave Himself for them.

Possessing Our Inheritance: Prayer for 21 Unreached Cities

Vientiane, Laos

Population: 220,000

Major Religion: Buddhism

Language: Lao

- The government controls message bearers and their work within the country. Pray for a move of the Holy Spirit than no human can control that would move hearts toward repentance and draw them into relationship with the Lord Almighty.

- Pray for freedom for these message bearers that though they live in difficult and oppressive circumstances they would trust the Holy Spirit to lead them to those who are hungry. Pray also for boldness for these message bearers to confidently proclaim Christ's love.

## Day 14

### ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

#### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

Psalm 119:18 – “Open my eyes, that I may see wondrous things from Your law.”

The Word of God grows dark and dry when we lose the hunger and thirst. Some go for days or weeks without getting meaningfully into the Word. Confess and repent of every lack of thirst for the Word and its neglect. Ask for a fresh hunger and thirst for the Word. (Psalm 119:176)

#### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Growing in Experiential Knowledge of Jesus' Supremacy: Colossians 1:15-20 – Jesus is not just one among many but the only way to the Father. All things were created by Him and it is only through Him that we can find our true fulfillment.

- Ask God to show you anew that all things begin and end with Jesus. Pray for the Lord to give you revelation on how this understanding will revolutionize your relationship with Christ.

- God was pleased that all the fullness dwells in Christ. Ask the Father to show you the fullness He intends in your spiritual walk.

#### Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

University of Bucharest – location: Bucharest, Romania

Isaiah 64:1-2 – “Oh that You would rend the heavens! That You would come down! That the mountains might shake at Your presence – as the fire burns brushwood, as fire causes water to boil – to make Your name known to Your adversaries, that the nations may tremble at Your presence!”

- Pray for the Lord to bring a shaking to Bucharest at the University of Bucharest. Pray that the Lord's name would be known throughout that university and for many to see God's works and commit themselves to go to the nations. Revival shakes things up. Revival brings attention to God and His majesty and awesome power.

- Pray God would give many wise counselors to the students. As they hear God leading them to the nations, ask for the way to be made clear and the path to be smooth. It is not as easy for a Romanian to get to the field as a European or westerner. Ask God to make the rough places smooth and the crooked places straight so that they can fulfill God's call and bring revival full circle to some other part of the world.

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION: WHEN DRY BONES LIVE, THEN WHAT?

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

Revelation 5:13 – “And every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: ‘Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever!’”

Father, thank You that the day is coming when every creature will join in unison to proclaim Your glory. Together heaven and earth will be pointed in one direction, resounding with one voice, focused on one task – worshipping the Lamb. Let our hearts even now not wait one more day to join together in worshipping Your holy Name. Let us not put off praying together to see the harvest come forth so that every creature might respond to the love of Jesus. The task is too great to wait. Lord, we cry out to convict our hearts of the urgency to see every creature hear of Your great love. Penetrate our calloused hearts when we think that the Lord should send someone else when we know You are calling us. In Jesus' name, Amen.

### Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Manipulation

- Pray that message bearers would resist others trying to manipulate them, their actions, and decisions. Ask God to help them recognize the manipulation as it is happening and have the Holy Spirit remind them of God's call in the midst of it.
- Ask God to give them great strength to press into God and fulfill God's call regardless of the pressure they feel from others around them.

### Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

2 Timothy 1:7 – “For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.”

Ask God to free our generation from the snare of the fear of men. There is only One whom we should fear, God Himself. Open our hearts to the fear of God (Proverbs 1:7) and make us obedient to speak forth as God leads us.

## **Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized**

Brazil: 2 Corinthians 12:9 – “And He said to me, ‘My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.’ Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities that the power of Christ may rest upon me.”

- Pray for students across Brazil to embrace their weaknesses and count them as ways to see the power of Christ displayed for His glory. Ask God to give them abundant grace as they embrace these weaknesses that they may see Christ’s strength made perfect.
- Pray for the Lord to raise up a mighty wave of students who depend upon God’s grace as they are sent out to the nations to share God’s love.

## **Possessing Our Inheritance: Prayer for 21 Unreached Cities**

Kuwait City, Kuwait

Population: 2,380,000 (metropolitan area)

Major Religion: Islam

Language: Arabic

- Because this is one of the wealthiest countries in the world per capita, pray for the hearts of Kuwaiti citizens to not be ensnared by the things of this world but willing instead to sell all that they have to purchase the pearl of great price. Pray that they would desire relationship with Jesus Christ more than anything this world can offer.
- Pray for message bearers to have open doors to speak with these people and share the gospel with them. Ask God for many churches to be raised up and for new believers to be discipled and trained.

## ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

1 Corinthians 12:12-13 – “For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ. For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body – whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free – and have all been made to drink into one Spirit.”

Confess and repent of every neglect of fellowship with believers and a critical spirit towards others or the Church in general. We hurt ourselves when we are not bonding with the brethren. (Heb. 10:25)

### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Waiting Upon God in Trust and Dependence: Psalm 37:1-7 – Waiting on God is not an idle activity of simply passing time, but instead it is an active engagement with God to see His promises come to pass by trusting His character and power to accomplish all that He has promised. In waiting, we must also learn to depend upon Him and not our flesh, always looking with faith to see Him in our midst.

- Pray for patience to wait upon God and trust Him even though there is no physical evidence for faith and trust.
- Ask the Lord to deepen your trust in Him and teach you to depend on Him and not on your own ideas or understanding.

### Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

NEGST-Nairobi Evangelical Graduate School of Theology (Now called NIS-Nairobi International School)-location Nairobi, Kenya

Matthew 10:38-39 – “If you don’t go all the way with Me, through thick and thin, you don’t deserve Me. If your first concern is to look after yourself, you’ll never find yourself. But if you forget about yourself and look to Me, you’ll find both yourself and Me.” (The Message)

- Students from different parts of the world, particularly from different parts of Africa study at NEGST, and consequently there is a huge potential at NEGST. Pray for a spiritual breakthrough, so that believers are willing to re-embrace God the way that God desires.
- Students at NEGST have a lot to offer to others. Pray for a self-giving attitude: unless we forget

ourselves, we cannot find, and when we don't find, we cannot give.

- Pray for believers not to have their confidence or diffidence in what they have or what they need, but in what they can offer.

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION: WHEN DRY BONES LIVE, THEN WHAT?

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

Matthew 9:37-38 – “Then He said to His disciples, “The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.”

Jesus, together with one voice throughout the body of Christ we acknowledge Your call to send out more laborers and together we seek to answer that call. We see that one organization cannot send out enough workers for all to hear the good news and neither can one denomination. We understand that it will take the whole body of Christ working together. We ask Lord that You would unify national student mission movements that together whole nations would mobilize and send forth their young people to see a massive harvest in the earth. We ask for unity in Ghana and Nigeria among students and student mobilizers, among churches and college fellowships, among pastors and leaders of sending organizations. Let their passion for God's heart and their goal of seeing every creature given the chance to respond to Jesus' love unite them and move them onward in their upward calling in Christ Jesus. In the name of Jesus and by His shed blood on the cross we ask these things, Amen.

### Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Criticalness

- Ask God that a spirit of grace would be upon message bearers and that rather than being critical of others they would be loving and kind.
- Pray they would be able to hear God's voice clearly and discern His will, not looking just to the negative but knowing that God's plans are good and He gives us a future and a hope.

### Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

2 Corinthians 5:14 – “For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died.”

Pray that the emerging generation would be marked by the love of Christ, that every action and word would portray the glorious love that brought us out of darkness and into His glorious light. Pray that those that seek to speak into the lives of others will be compelled by Christ's love. (Eph. 4:15)

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Argentina: 2 Corinthians 4:6 – “For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.”

- Pray for light to pierce and convict their hearts that they cannot keep the light to themselves but they must share it with those who have not heard.
- Pray for multitudes of students to rise up and go to the nations that they would be lights shining in the darkness in unreached places.

## Possessing Our Inheritance: Prayer for 21 Unreached Cities

Male, Maldives

Population: 105,000

Major Religion: Sunni Islam

Language: Dhivehi

- Since the population of the entire country is only about 300,000, foreigners are easily spotted. Pray for creative ideas for platforms for message bearers who are desiring to reach this city.
- Pray for the hearts of these people to be softened and hungry for truth. Pray for those who do turn to Christ to be radical with their faith. Can you imagine the impact of a few radical followers of Jesus on this small nation?

# Day 16

## ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

## Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

1 John 3:18 – “My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth.”

We often give a lot of lip-service to missions. Confess and repent for you and your generation for every noise without sacrificial commitment toward the remaining unreached peoples of the world. Pray that our commitment will shine brightly in our closets.

## Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Submitting to Jesus' Pruning Hand: John 15:2 – Sometimes it is hard to understand why God would cut back those things that are producing fruit in our lives. But God is jealous for our love and doesn't want us to be caught up in looking to the fruit that we miss doing things out of a deep love for Him and Him alone.

- Ask God that He would make the work of your hands fruitful, that He would find you fruitful for His kingdom when He comes to judge the world.
- Pray for understanding when you enter into a pruning season. Ask God to reveal to you the purpose of the pruning and then press into the Lord for all that He has for you in that moment.

## Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

Texas A&M University – location: College Station, Texas, USA

2 Corinthians 4: 10-11 – “Always carrying about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body. For we who live are always delivered to death for Jesus' sake, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh.”

- In order to know the resurrection power of Christ in us and through us we must also join Christ in dying. Pray for the students at Texas A&M to embrace being fully surrendered to the Lord, death to self, death to flesh, death to everything that isn't Christ and Him alone.
- Pray for the life of Jesus to fill them. As they empty out themselves, may they be filled to overflowing with more of Christ than they have ever dreamed of. Ask God to remind them that greater works than Christ they will do, but only to the degree that Christ lives in them.

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION: WHEN DRY BONES LIVE, THEN WHAT?

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

1 Corinthians 12:12 – “For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ.”

Father God, thank You for the diversity of Your creation. Thank You for the wisdom in making us each unique so that we may complement one another and find freedom in interdependence, rather than the pressure of looking only to ourselves. Lord of the harvest we ask that You would use the many different giftings in the body throughout Romania, South Africa, and the United States. In Your infinite wisdom, bring together those who would complement each other, acknowledging their weaknesses would You

unite them through their strengths to bring the most glory to Your name. Let us steward the manifold grace that has been given to each of us that we might reflect our glorious Maker and Redeemer. Let us not shy away from or even disdain the interconnectedness of the body but rather love and encourage one another to love and good deeds as the day of Christ's return quickly approaches. May He find us, His bride and His body, united in possessing the inheritance He has promised. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Legalism

- Pray that God would let the scales of legalism fall from the eyes of message bearers so that they can see clearly the mandate of God to go to the unreached because of Christ's love for the lost.
- Ask God to help them not to be rigid in the way they see their ministry on the field but to flexible as to how the Spirit might lead them.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

2 Corinthians 4:7 – “But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us.”

Pray for the humility to know we desperately need God's power in order to make a difference, since we have no power within ourselves. Ask God to anoint us with His power.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Peru: Romans 1:3-4 – “Concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh, and declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.”

- Pray for students across Peru to prepare themselves to declare the One and only God Jesus Christ our Lord. Ask God to fill them with power to declare it among the nations.
- Pray for these students to be holy vessels of Christ's love and power to witness to the nations of Christ's own holiness. Ask God to bring down the barriers that would hold these students from going to those who have not heard.

Nouakchott, Mauritania

Population: 2,000,000

Major Religion: Islam

Language: Arabic, French

- Pray for an awakening on the campus of the only university in the country, Université de Nouakchott. Ask God for many students to hunger for the truth and turn their lives to Christ their only hope of salvation.
  - Ask God bring revival to the slum on the outskirts of Nouakchott. Pray that as these families are in transition while being resettled in new neighborhoods that they would desire to know the Rock on whom they can depend in every circumstance.

## Day 17

### ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

#### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

Philippians 3:18-19 – “For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: whose end is destruction, whose god is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame – who set their mind on earthly things.”

When we have repented of our own sins we are ready to repent on behalf of our generation and the Church in general. Confess and repent of the enthronement of self-worship, empire-building and entertainment in much of the Church today. (Rev. 3:17) Ask for a revival of a hunger for God alone.

#### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Walking Worthy of the Lord: Colossians 1:10 – In all that God has called us to do, we must seek to walk worthy of the Lord. Paul explains this phrase as seeking to fully please the Lord, being fruitful in every work, and increasing in the knowledge of God.

- Tell the Lord that the desire of your heart is to be fully pleasing to Him and to seek His face all of your days.
- Ask God to bring fruitfulness to every work that you do because fruitfulness only comes from Him. Also ask Him to increase your knowledge of Him, His character, His ways, His heart, and His thoughts.

# Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

Bandung Institute of Technology – location: Bandung, Indonesia

Psalm 106:1, 3 – “Praise the LORD! Oh give thanks to the LORD, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever. ... Blessed are those who keep justice, and he who does righteousness at all times!”

- Ask God to make these students people who are filled with praise. May they praise with power to war in the heavenlies. Praise is a powerful weapon of warfare. As our hearts are renewed and revived in revival, our hearts are filled with thankfulness. Satan hates nothing more than a saint who knows the source of their salvation.

- As revival sweeps across this campus, ask God to compel these students to keep justice and do righteousness as outward signs of inward relationship with God. Pray for the Lord to reveal the desperate need of those who have not heard the gospel to these students and give them hearts that sincerely want to respond to God’s call for more laborers.

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

Matthew 28:19 – “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.”

Jesus, we cry out for You to raise up national student mission movements in other parts of Africa, Eastern Europe, Asia, and South America. We ask for multitudes of students who would unite their hearts with Yours, oh God, and make their declaration to “GO” to the least reached, hardest places, to declare the most wonderful, glorious news of a Savior who has died for their sins and lives that they may live in abundance. Lord, unite these students in purpose, burn in them one pure and holy passion for Your name and Your glory, fix their eyes on Your glorious desire to see all nations worshiping before Your throne. Raise up young people full of zeal who will together do more than they could ever do on their own. Show them the power found in the household of faith. We unite our hearts right now and as one voice we cry out for 100,000 new message bearers from nations all over the earth to “GO” to those who haven’t heard and proclaim the day of salvation, the year of jubilee, the reign of Christ in their hearts forever more. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

### Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Pride

- Pray for message bearers not to let their pride derail them into a huge fall. Pray for them to have discernment into their own hearts and accurately assess their spirituality.

- Ask God to humble these message bearers now so that they will go to the field positioned in the spiritual realm to make a maximum impact in the kingdom.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

James 5:16 – “Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.”

Ask God to raise up many more small groups of accountability and fellowship where healing and growth happen through transparency. Pray for these groups to inspire and compel one another to follow God’s heart, no matter what the cost.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Ukraine: John 11:25 - “I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live.”

- Pray for these students to be constantly reminded Christ did not just die for them but rose that we all might have new life. Pray these students to surrender these new lives into Christ’s hands, ready to die if it means others might receive new life as well.
- Pray for multitudes of students to go out that they would encourage one another all the more in their faith that Christ is sufficient in His resurrection power in every circumstance.

Casablanca, Morocco

Population: 3,535,000

Major Religion: Islam

Language: Arabic

- Pray for message bearers to take the Bible into villages and use it to teach young girls to read because the literacy rate is so low, especially among girls. Pray that hearts would be opened as they read God’s word and they would hunger for truth.
- Pray for the churches to be established in this city and for many to come to Christ and be discipled.

## ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

James 2:1 – “My brethren, do not hold the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with partiality.”

Repent of the divisions, racism and favoritism in your own heart and in the church today in some parts of the world. Pray for a restoration of fervent love for all the brethren. (1 Corinthians 3:3-4)

### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Embracing Jesus’ Terms of Discipleship: Luke 9:23 – Jesus desires that we would be His disciples, but we must count the cost before we fully understand what it means to follow Him. We are called to deny ourselves, take up our cross daily and follow Him. Are we ready to embrace these terms of discipleship?

- Pray for the Lord to humble your heart and make you willing to deny yourself in order to pursue God’s will for your life.
- The road of discipleship is lined with obstacles that represent suffering in our lives. Ask the Lord to help you embrace the suffering and learn to lean on Jesus in those times.

### Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

Nanyang Technological University (NTU), Location: Nanyang Avenue, Singapore

Matthew 9:38 – “Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.”

- Ask God to raise up laborers from NTU to help reach NTU students and the nations.
- Pray that NTU Christians will fear the Lord and see the importance of following the ways of the Master.
- Pray for pre-believers in NTU to see and understand Jesus’ sacrifice and love for them.

## Unity Brings Life & an Army

1 Corinthians 15:58 – “Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.”

Holy Spirit, come and remind us that unity takes work. Teach us that doing events together isn't unity. Help us understand the profound love and concern for one another that breeds the deep bonds of unity in our hearts and not just on a piece of paper. Let us not give up easily but be steadfast in our pursuit of working together for the sake of the Kingdom. When the seasons of trial come to test the relationships that have been built, make us immovable, and unwilling to give room to the enemy or his schemes. Through unity, let us abound in the work of the Lord. We ask for an abundant harvest, a massive revival, a mighty outpouring of the Spirit in the lives of people around the world. For Your glory, in Jesus' name, Amen.

## Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Ignorance of Scripture

- Message bearers who do not know the Word of God can easily become lost in the schemes of the enemy or subject to the whims of the flesh. Pray for message bearers to have a hunger for the Word of God, to read and meditate on the truths of God's Word, and to memorize Scripture.
- Pray that the Word of God would not just be words on a page but meaningful truths that go deep in their hearts.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

Mark 1:35 – “Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, He went out and departed to a solitary place, and there he prayed.”

Beyond His speaking through people, God longs to speak individually to us. Pray that God will bring a strong emphasis among us on consistent private times of personal devotion. Pray for a hunger and desire to arise in the emerging generation to have these times with God on a daily basis. Pray that they would so hunger for them that even one day apart from time with God would drive them back to His presence.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Mexico: John 6:27 – “Do not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set his seal on Him.”

- Pray for students to give their lives and their labor for the food that endures to everlasting life. Ask God to give them sacrificial lives that would give their own lives so others might know the everlasting life.
- Pray for perseverance to go, though the road may be difficult, to the hardest places in the world.

Karachi, Pakistan

Population: 11,774,000

Major Religions: Islam, Hinduism, Sikhs

Languages: English (official), Urdu, Punjabi, Pashto, Sindhi, Balochi

- Karachi is the financial capital of Pakistan. Ask God to awaken the hearts of these financial business men with a desire for freedom, truth, and hope. Pray for small groups of business men to come together to study God's Word and pray together.
- Ask God for more message bearers to go to Karachi and reach this strategic city with His love and compassion. Pray for God to move on the hearts of students around the globe to be burdened with a desire to go to Pakistan.

## Day 19

### ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

#### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

Isaiah 58:6-7 – “Is this not the fast that I have chosen: to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, to let the oppressed go free, and that you break every yoke? Is it not to share your bread with the hungry, and that you bring to your house the poor who are cast out; when you see the naked, that you cover him, and not hide yourself from your own flesh?”

Very few churches are carrying the burden of our call to the poor and widows and orphans. (James 1:27) Repent of this lack of heart for the lost and the poor. Pray for compassion and passion for souls. (Matt. 9:36)

#### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Walking in Meekness: Numbers 12:3 – The Lord described Moses as the most humble and meek man on the face of the earth. Moses knew the Lord Almighty. He knew that he was not anything compared

to the greatness of God. He also knew that the Lord loved him and His people, and he was confident in that love.

- Pray for a revelation of meekness and an understanding of how to walk in meekness in your daily life.
- Ask the Lord to give you a confidence and trust in His love for you. Pray that God would teach you the difference between pride and confidence and give you grace to walk in the latter.

## Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

University of Cape Town – Location: Cape Town, South Africa

Isaiah 40:30-31 – “Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall, but those who wait on the LORD shall renew their strength. They shall mount up with wings like eagles. They shall run and not be weary. They shall walk and not faint.”

- Pray for the emerging generation in Cape Town to wait on the Lord for strength. Ask God to show them that in the midst of difficulties and seeming impossibilities to wait on the Lord of possibility.
- Ask God to prepare their hearts for sharing the love that they have received with every person they meet. Pray for God to enable them to run the race and not grow weary, to walk and not faint.

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

2 Chronicles 7:14 – “If My people who are called by My name, will humble themselves, pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.”

Father, we so often forget that Your desire to come and heal our land is based upon us coming together as Your people, united in our humility, united in our prayers, united in seeking Your face, and united in repentance. Jesus, we confess our lack of unity with our brothers and sisters. We confess our lack of humility, being turf conscious rather than Kingdom oriented. Make us humble in relationships with others not putting ourselves first but seeing how we might serve others first. We confess our lack of prayerfulness for others rather than just ourselves and our ministry or church. Holy Spirit, bring to our remembrance those for whom we need to pray. Lord, we have failed but we haven't given up. Our hope rests solely in You. Come and wash over us. Holy Spirit, come and lead us into truth. Jesus open our eyes like You did for Bartimaeus that we would see our need – our need for humility, prayer, repentance, and unity. In Jesus' name, Amen.

# Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Self-dependence

- Ask God to reveal to message bearers the lie of the world that we have to do it all ourselves. Pray for God to show them how small their view of God is if they can't learn to rely and trust in Him.
- Pray for the truth that we have been crucified with Christ and we no longer live but Christ lives in us to go deep and transform their understanding of reliance upon God for everything.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

Mark 10:27 – “But Jesus looked at them and said, ‘With men it is impossible, but not with God; for with God all things are possible.’”

As the emerging generation looks toward the task of fulfilling the great commission, pray that they would look with eyes of faith in God's ability to accomplish it in this generation, not their own ability. Pray that they would see that all things are possible – seeing masses of young people accept the call to go, getting to the field, seeing the lost come to know Jesus, and seeing believers disciples.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Kazakstan: Ezra 1:4 – “And whoever is left in any place where he dwells, let the men of his place help him with silver and gold, with goods and livestock, besides the freewill offerings for the house of God which is in Jerusalem.”

- Pray for Kazak students to not fear God's call to the nations but to willingly go, fervently seeking God's face, and passionately sharing God's love with all they meet. Pray for many students for every university and campus across the country to be sent out to the nations.
- Pray for the Kazak church to send these students out exceedingly blessed spiritually, emotionally, financially, and with much prayer. Pray that many would give sacrificially to see these students fulfill God's call to go to the unreached.

- Riyadh is a difficult city for message bearers. Pray for many message bearers who would go to this difficult place to reach these precious people with God's love.

Matthew 21:13 – “And He said to them, ‘It is written, ‘My house shall be called a house of prayer,’ but you have made it a ‘den of thieves.’”

Confess and repent for the Church's lack of a heart for the nations. Repent for the pride and strife between churches and missions groups that takes the focus off the Lord. Pray that our churches will become houses of prayer for all nations. Let us not rob the Lord of the glory due His name from every tribe and tongue and nation and people.

#### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Attuning Our Ear to the Voice of God: 1 Samuel 3:10 – The Lord desires to speak to us, but we have to tune our ears to hear His voice and recognize Him speaking to us. Samuel learned that God was speaking to him and then responded in such a way to invite a conversation.

- Pray for God to tune your ears to hear His voice that you would recognize His voice speaking to you.
- Ask the Lord to make your response to be one where you seek to enter into dialogue with God. Don't pass over God's invitation – pause and seek His face!

# Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

University of Manila – location: Manila, Philippines

Luke 18:1 – “Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart.”

- Pray for desperation within their hearts, souls, and minds that without Him they won't make it. Pray that they would resemble the widow who kept going to the judge, refusing to give up, refusing to let God rest until He brings revival to them and their universities.
- Pray for them to be people of prayer who would pray in revival, pray in the laborers to be sent out, pray in the harvest, pray over the new believers to become passionate disciples. God make them prayer warriors!

## GLOBAL PROCLAMATION: WHEN DRY BONES LIVE, THEN WHAT?

### Unity Brings Life & an Army

Isaiah 60:1-2 – “Arise, shine; for your light has come! And the glory of the LORD is risen upon you. For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and deep darkness the people; but the LORD will arise over you, and His glory will be seen upon you.”

Lord God Almighty, for every national student mission movement we cry out for the glory of the Lord to rise upon them. Though we live in dark times, when people have been blinded by the dark schemes of the enemy, yet will His message bearers be sent out with the glory of the Lord upon their heads, covering them as they go in and go out in dark places all over the earth. Let message bearers from these national student mission movements be marked by the presence of the Lord. May the peace and love and unity of Jesus Christ radiate from them and be more contagious than the darkness around them. Thank You Jesus that Your light cannot be overtaken by the darkness nor can the darkness understand it. For those living in darkness, enlighten the eyes of their hearts and let them see with eyes of faith the love of the Father waiting for them. In Jesus' name, Amen.

### Barriers to Seeing the Army Mobilized

Disobedience

- Pray for the sin of disobedience to overwhelm each message bearer as the serious sin that it is with God. Ask God to give message bearers a right understanding of God's standard of righteousness.
- Ask God to reveal His desire for relationship and that He only asks that they confess their sins. Pray for message bearers to have a heart that yearns for instantaneous obedience that flows from a heart fully devoted to God.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

Revelation 22:17 – “And the Spirit and the bride say, ‘Come!’ And let him who hears say, ‘Come!’ And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely.”

History shows how God has often used the student movement as a prophetic voice to the larger Body of Christ. Ask God to do it again in our generation and use us to communicate the breath of God upon his body. Ask God to “COME!”

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Taiwan: Esther 4:14 – “For if you remain silent at this time, relief and deliverance will arise for the Jews from another place, but you and your father’s house will perish. Yet who knows whether you have come to the kingdom for such a time as this?”

- Pray for these precious saints to recognize the hour in history and that the emerging generation is in a pivotal moment. Ask God to reveal to them their part in fulfilling the great commission in our lifetime.
- Pray for many students to hear the call to go to the nations, pray for ears to be opened, blind eyes to see, hard hearts to understand the cost and call. The road will be difficult but the reward will be infinitely more than we could ever dream to see.

## Possessing Our Inheritance: Prayer for 21 Unreached Cities

Dakar, Senegal

Population: 1,500,000

Major Religion: Islam

Languages: French (official), Wolof, Soninke, Seereer-Siin, Fula, Maninka, Diola

- Many people groups call Senegal home. Pray for the Lord to spread revival throughout the city of Dakar touching all of these various people groups. Ask God to soften their hearts and make them hungry for God’s word which is the only thing that gives life.
- Pray for hundreds of message bearers to go to Dakar and touch these people’s lives with the love of Jesus and to go out from this city into the many villages to tell those who have never heard of our Savior Jesus Christ.

## ABANDONED DEVOTION: BRINGING LIFE TO DRY BONES

### Repentance: Taking out Hearts of Stone for Hearts of Flesh

Ezekiel 36:26 – “I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.”

Thank God for the fact that He has replaced yours as well as that of countless in your generation during the past 21 days from a heart of stone to a heart of flesh. Pray that the Lord would remind you to be watchful over your heart and not let the stones creep back in to your heart.

### Wholeheartedness: No Bone Left Without Sinews and Breath

Maturing as a Servant: John 15:20 – We are called to mature as servants of Christ, to follow Him even if it means persecution. We are called to count the cost and know that the Lord is worth our life and our death, our joy and our pain, our happiness and our sufferings.

- Ask the Lord to mature you as a servant in His kingdom. Pray for God to show you that He is worth all of our worship and service.
- Pray for a willingness to endure persecution in order to follow the King of kings. Ask God to help you to not be ashamed of the gospel but to be ready to give your life to honor and glorify your Lord and Savior.

### Revival: A Massive Number of Dry Bones Brought to Life

Luke 17:20-21 – “Now when He was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, “The kingdom of God does not come with observation; nor will they say, ‘See here!’ or ‘See there!’ For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you.”

- Ask God to raise up a righteous generation of believers in every country. Pray for revival to sweep across the country and be more infectious than any disease known to man. Ask God to change the hearts of students from the inside out. Pray for God to make and mold them in His image.
- Pray for the believers all around the globe to be fascinated by the person of Jesus, compelled by His compassion, passionate about proclaiming His purposes, fixed on Him with eyes of faith, thoroughly enthralled with His teachings, lavishly loving others with the love they have received from Him.

Finances/Resources

- Ask God to open the windows of heaven and pour out the finances and resources necessary to fulfill God’s call to go to the nations with the message of God’s love.
- Pray for churches to catch the vision and passion for going to the unreached and ask God to move on their hearts to give generously in order to see many people hear the message of God’s love in a culturally relevant way.

## Receiving the Breath of God to Enter into Our Inheritance

1 Thessalonians 5:18 – “In everything give thanks, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.”

Thank God for how through your prayers He is breathing His breathe upon us. Thank Him for His Word that He is sending and all the answers to your prayers.

## Mobilizing the Army: Prayer for 21 Nations to be Mobilized

Germany: Jeremiah 33:3 – “Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.”

- Pray for students on universities throughout Germany to call on God with fervent and abandoned devotion. Ask God to turn them to His will and purposes in the earth.
- Pray for revelations of God’s heart for the nations and those who have not heard the gospel. Ask the Lord to show them His deep love for the lost sheep around the world.

Ask God to meet these people with the peace of Christ in the midst of trying to save the lives of their families.

Pray that more laborers would be sent to this city and that though there are trials and struggles the laborers would know victory through people coming to Christ.
